Nanyang Technological University

Singapore Institute of Technology

Progression depends on grades, course fit and admission requirements.

Funding support, legal work conditions and first-week essentials need the same care as the application.

01

Tuition Grant

Eligible international students in selected full-time programmes may receive subsidised tuition. Recipients generally serve a three-year work obligation in Singapore after graduation.

02

HESL student finance

Eligible international students in approved MOE-subsidised programmes may apply. HESL is interest-free during study; assessment and prevailing terms apply.

03

Part-time work eligibility

Qualifying full-time Student's Pass holders at approved institutions may work up to 16 hours weekly during term, subject to MOM rules.

04

Accommodation readiness

Shortlist areas by commute, budget, lease conditions and household rules before committing.

05

Arrival essentials

Prepare Student's Pass formalities, SIM, transport, medical checks, insurance and campus check-in steps.

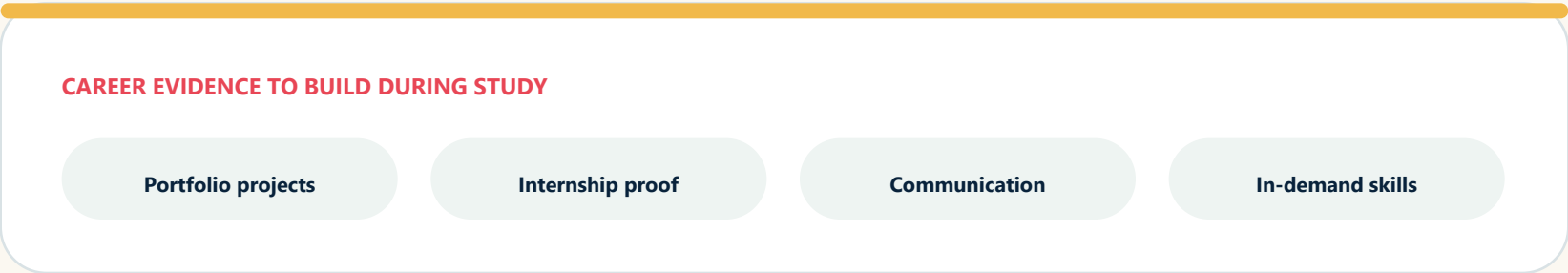
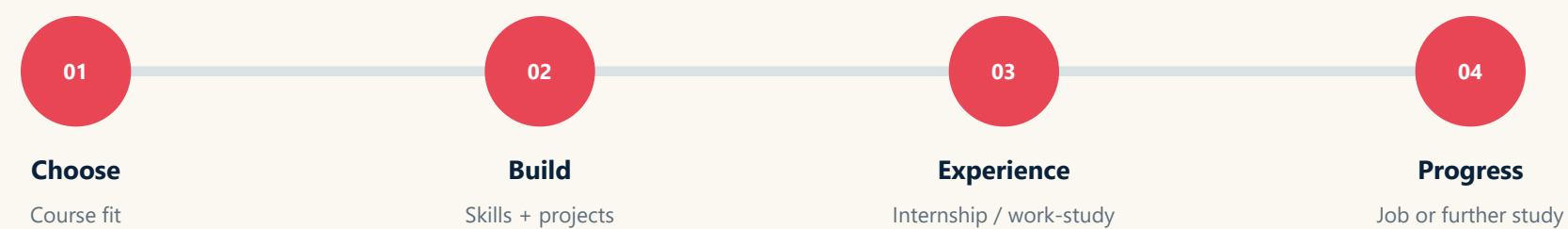

Use a shared deadline and document tracker so students and parents know the next milestone.
